**Re: SKY CENTRAL CHARLESTOWN INSTALLATION OF FOOTBRIDGE OVER
PACIFIC HIGHWAY, SUNDAY 25TH JULY 2010**

The bridge will be installed on the night of Sunday 25th July 2010. In order to install the bridge a closure and detour of the Pacific Highway will be required. The works have been planned to occur at night to minimise the impacts on local businesses, residents and road users.

The Pacific Highway will be closed and detoured via the following route, for the time periods given.

SOUTHBOUND - Detour via Ridley, Smith and Frederick streets.
From 6.00pm Sunday to 5.00am Monday.

NORTHBOUND - Detour via Frederick, Smith and Ridley Streets
From 9.00pm Sunday to 5.00am Monday

In addition to this Smart Street will be closed from between Smith Street and Pearson Street from 6.00pm Sunday to 5.00am Monday.

Pedestrian access will be maintained along the Pacific Highway between Ridley and Frederick Streets, except for an exclusion zone at the work site immediately south of Smart Street.

Whilst the detour is in place there will be increased traffic along Ridley, Smith and Frederick Streets. Residents are asked to take extra care, when using these roads. Traffic Controllers will be stationed at various positions in the area to direct traffic and it is requested that you follow the directions given by the Traffic Controllers.

In addition to the works on the Sunday night, there will be some ongoing night works over the following week to complete the bridge. These works will be carried out with various lane closures on the Pacific Highway, but will not require a detour.
